\_\_\_\_\_ **1. ORAL HISTORY LOGS** – Each student needs to complete 2 oral history logs.  
\_\_\_\_\_ Listen to your oral history or read the transcript. Then follow the directions on the  
\_\_\_\_\_ oral history log. Divide up the three/four best parts of the interview and each  
\_\_\_\_\_ person takes on that portion of the tape.

**2. Research Paper –**

- Agree who is going to work on which portion of the project. Initial in the blank next to the task.

The Paper needs to be typed, double-spaced, & 2 - 3 – pgs. in length. Include a title page (title of project, group names, the class/instructor(s), and date), cite with footnotes or endnotes (see the example provided), and a bibliography (see the format).

\_\_\_\_\_ - begin with an introduction- at least a full paragraph 8 – 10 sentences

ALL - the body of the paper needs to be 2 – 3 pages long:

\* describe the setting – place - time & overall world picture

\* tell about your individual’s background, and his path into and through WWII

\* Body of the paper:

- describe the theater of war – focus in detail on at least one major battle/event

- write about your vets. role – include some interesting stories

EACH MEMBER SELECTS A PART OF HIS STORY AND WRITES IT

-what happened after the war

\_\_\_\_\_ **3. Produce the maps** – They need to show the veterans story- a personal map for that individual – The maps need to be visible to the class during your presentation (overheads, poster-size etc.)  
Include a title, border, clear printing, & legend.
